Printed books by Filipino authors; books about the Philippines regardless of author, language, and publisher's imprint; and books published by Filipinos in any subject.

Reserve Books

Reading materials for courses offered during the semester/midyear that have been requested by faculty for the students' use.

Reference Books

Print reference books such as encyclopedias, dictionaries, atlases, directories, almanacs, etc.

Circulation Books

Composed of foreign print books in various subject areas supporting both the basic and professional courses from the different program offerings of the University.

Multimedia Resources

Microfilm and microfiche copies of periodicals, video and sound recordings, slides; kits; and other non-book materials.

Serials and Periodicals

Covers Foreign and local journals and other periodicals including Filipiniana abstracts, and indexes in agriculture which cover major subject areas and other general and specialized areas.

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About Us

The University of the Philippines Los Baños Library (formerly the UP College of Agriculture Library) was established at the founding of the College of Agriculture in 1909. Presently, it is composed of the Main Library, seven Colleges, three Research Libraries, a School Library, and a High School Library. It offers a wide range of information sources in both print and electronic formats.

The UPLB Library provides library services both online and face-to-face (F2F) to meet the instructional, research, extension, and public service needs of the various constituents of the University. It also offers learning and collaborative spaces to support students, faculty, and staff in their pursuit of academic advancement, as well as in developing collaborative, creative, and critical thinking skills.

It conducts the InfoSkilled Program which empowers library users and individuals to search for, acquire, evaluate, and use information responsibly while raising awareness of social and legal responsibilities. Additionally, the UPLB Library provides assistance in the use of Information Communication Technology (ICT) for research and study and ensures the protection and preservation of its materials through effective digitization and archiving efforts.

Rebranding Information Literacy

INFOSKILLED SESSIONS

This program aims to support the UPLB constituents by providing information sources and services for their research needs by helping them acquire the necessary information literacy (IL) skills for lifelong learning.

LIBSMART

This component discusses the library orientation and is intended for freshmen students and other new members of the user community

INFOLITE

This single session intends to introduce the IL concepts to participants and is expected to be presented after the LibSmart.

INFOLIT ADVANCED

This component is the in-depth discussion of each information literacy skill and focuses on the four major IL skills: (1) IDENTIFY, (2) FIND, (3) EVALUATE, and (4) ACKNOWLEDGE.

LIBSMART+

This session on-demand gives the liberty to the requestor, whether a faculty member for his/her class or even a student to choose their topics.
